

GOMARIZ (a word of Suevian origin derived from "gomariza=vine shoot") is the oldest wine estate on the Iberian Peninsula; it dates back to the 10th century and is known as the "Golden Mile of Ribeiro" due to its exceptional qualities for growing vines. The Carreiro family, returned emigrants, founded the winery in the 1980s. Today, 32 hectares of vineyards are cultivated solely with native varieties. It has been a pioneer in revealing that in the DO Ribeiro, in addition to whites, attractive reds with character can be made.

GOMARIZ - PAXARADAS

ORANGE WINE STYLE WHITE WINE, where maceration with the skins for 2 weeks gives it a different character to the rest. Golden yellow color pronounced nose of orange peel, grapefruit, quince accompanied by tomato leaf, dill, and other medicinal herbs. In the mouth it has a mediumhigh acidity and repeats the aromas of the nose in the retro nasal with a touch of nutmeg, hay and finishes long and very lively.

GOMARIZ - CASTE BRANCELLAO

Single-variety Brancellao RED WINE from the A Ferreira plot, high up in Gomariz. Produced as a natural wine (in the complete absence of sulphites) and aged in a 250-litre ceramic stoneware vessel for one year. Mediumintensity purple-red, with aromas of violets, red fruits: raspberry, cherries, sour strawberry and herbaceous notes such as tomato leaf, liquorice, flint and medicinal notes. Fresh and smooth on the palate, with soft fruit tannins, medium-bodied and highly intense flavour with a very long finish.

VX CUVEE PRIMO

RED WINE that honours the memory of grandfather Primo Carreiro, who planted many of the Gomariz vineyards, emigrated to South America and was a great wine lover. This limited and exclusive "cuvée" is a special selection from the A Ferreira plot, aged for 30 months in 500 I French oak barrels and with very good aging potential. It is only produced in exceptional vintages.

COFFEE LIQUOR made with the spirit from our distillery. Two gourmet coffees from high altitude coffee plantations are infused: Pico San Cristóbal (Colombia-Medellín Superior) and Volcán de Oro (Guatemala); which provide freshness and exquisite aromas to a spirit that ages for at least one year in the cellar.

THE FLOWER AND THE BEE

Dry single-varietal WHITE WINE from the youngest vines in Gomariz on mainly sandy soils.

Also labelled in its Spanish translation "LA FLOR Y LA ABEJA" or in Galician "A FLOR E A ABELLA".

The bees that pollinate the vine flower start the grape cycle; just as this reference marks the beginning of knowing the wines of Gomariz. Exquisite expression of the queen grape of Ribeiro: Treixadura. It is an aromatic wine, very balanced, with structure in the mouth and great freshness.

THE FLOWER AND THE BEE RED WINE oak monovarietal from the youngest vines in

Gomariz in mainly sandy soils.

Also labeled in its Spanish translation LA FLOR Y LA ABEJA or in Galician A FLOR E A ABELLA.

The bees that pollinate the vine flower start the cycle of the grapes; just as this reference marks the beginning of knowing the wines of Gomariz. The unique Sousón grape is aged for a few months in barrels resulting in a wine with character, red, black and violet fruit, fresh and very balanced.

COTO DE GOMARIZ

WHITE WINE that honors the history of our winery located in the oldest wine estate in the Iberian Peninsula since the 10th century (dende or Século X) considered the Golden Mile of Ribeiro. It expresses the personality of the Gomariz terroir in a blend of the best adapted white varieties, from the historic plots in the Pago de As Viñas: O Figueiral, A Fonte, Préstimo, Viña Grande, Lavandeira, A Cerrada, Lama de Barco and O Barreiro; planted in soils of clay, schist, and granite sand. Complex in aromas, balsamic, fleshy, fresh, and long.

ABADÍA DE GOMARIZ

RED WINE from the historic vineyards of the Carreiro family in Gomariz: Vilerma, Viña de Ramón, O Inferniño, O Campo, O Pazo and O Taboleiro with soils of clay, schist and granite sand. The blend of the best adapted red varieties is aged in 500 L French oak barrels for 12 months and appropriately aged in the bottle.

Its name honours the ancient 10th century Abbey located in Gomariz; the oldest wine estate in the Iberian Peninsula (dende or 10th century). Balanced Atlantic expression with polished tannins and a pleasant mid-palate with a fresh finish.

GOMARIZ X ALBARIÑO

WHITE WINE made from Albariño grown on soils of granite sand and schists (Xistos) from Gomariz, far from the direct influence of the sea, resulting in a mature, complex wine with a very balanced acidity. Very original and limited production, with aromas of ripe apple and a harmonious finish.

GOMARIZ X GODELLO

WHITE WINE from Godello grown on granitic sand soils on the SE-SW terraces of the O Taboleiro vineyard. X stands for "eXcepcionais vineyards" which means exceptional. It is a very original Godello from an iconic plot for Gomariz.

COTO DE GOMARIZ FINCA O FIGUEIRAL

WHITE WINE from the first plot restored by Caco Carreiro in 1978 with a blend of native varieties and represents a step forward in Ribeiro whites. It ferments spontaneously and is aged for around 10 months in 500 litre French oak barrels of different uses. It expresses the best version of the exclusive Gomariz terroir; a complex wine with a long finish that will evolve into a great white wine for ageing.

VX CUVEE CACO

RED WINE that honours the memory of Caco (nickname for Ricardo), founder of Coto de Gomariz. A visionary and intelligent emigrant who never separated himself from his origins and wanted to give Gomariz back its prestigious past. A Ferreira, located in a wonderful viewpoint facing SE over the Gomariz valley, was the Experimental Vineyard (VX) where the R&D was carried out to achieve the development of the ageing of Atlantic reds as wines for ageing.

This "cuvée" of native strains is aged for 20 months in 500L French oak barrels. Powerful, mature, elegant, and exquisitely fresh, VX Caco ages slowly and comfortably in the bottle. It is only produced in exceptional vintages.
